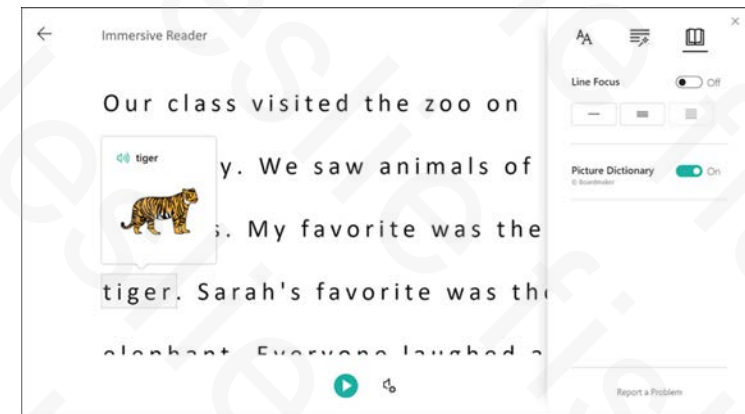


The Rise of Immersive Reader



Immersive Reader, Part of Microsoft Learning Tools

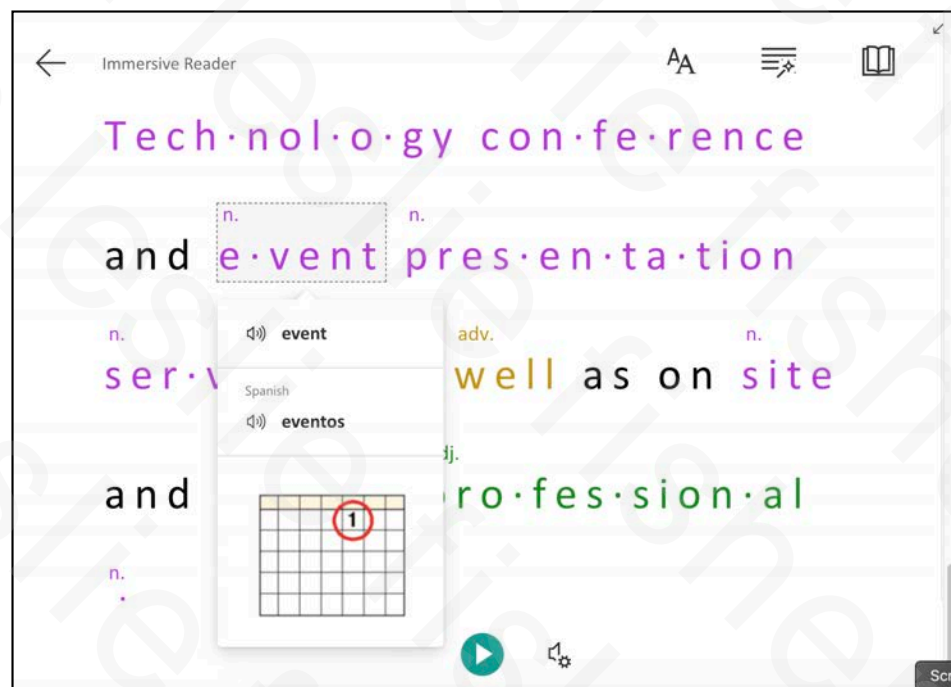
- Hands down one of my favorite Microsoft things. It's built into Word and OneNote online.
- Reads text out loud, breaks it into syllables, and increases spacing between lines and letters.
- Change background colors, click on words to see images of what those words are
- Translate into a multitude of language by the word or the entire document

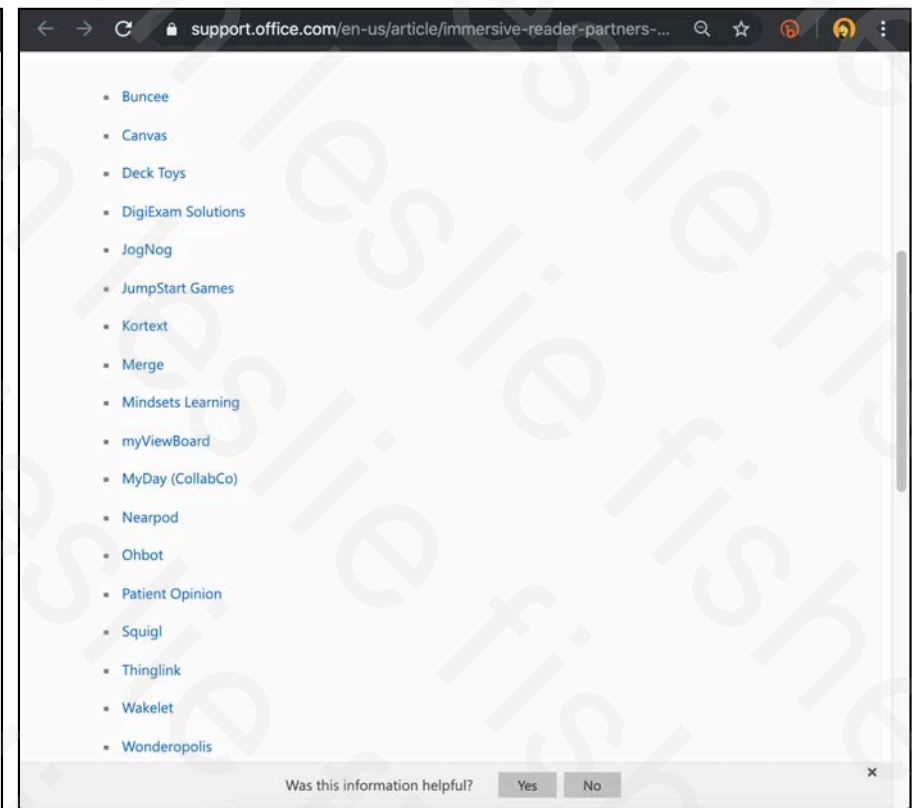
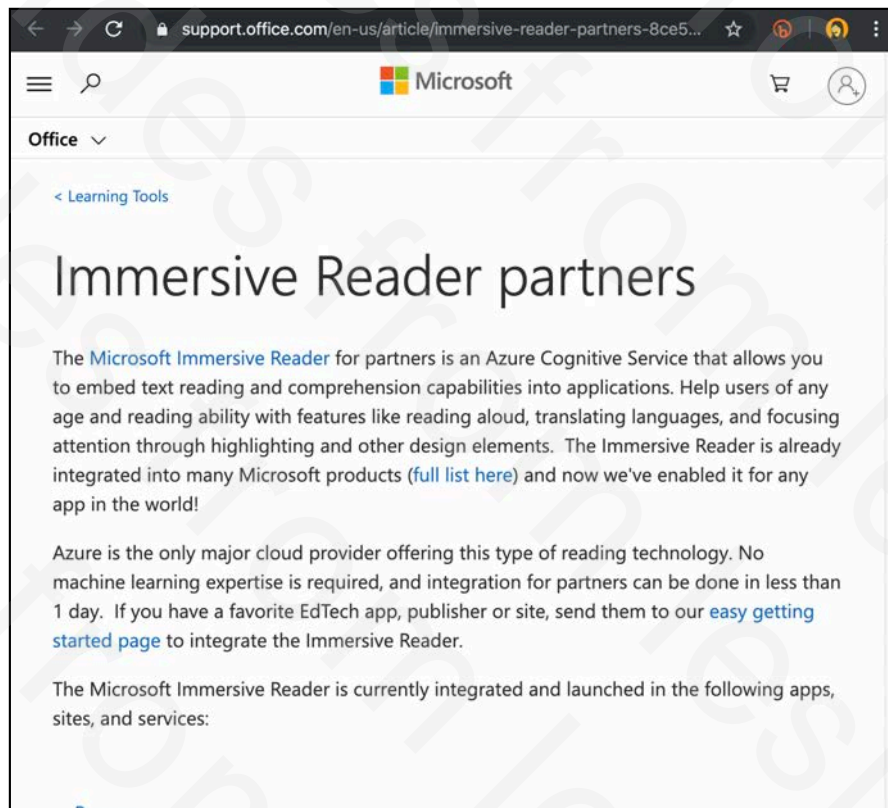
Immersive Reader is now a Chrome Extension!

- Your selected text will be displayed in a Chrome Browser running Immersive Reader

- Teachers creates a grid and asks a question
- Students then can record their thoughts via video to the grid
- Teacher can then like, comment, etc. and so can other people who are “on the grid” or you can leave the replies so only the teacher can see them
- Grids are private shared only via join code but can be opened up for the entire community to see.
- Constantly adding new features such as mix tapes, discovery library filled with grids for all, GridPals (think pen pals) and more
- Has become wildly popular all over the world

The New Flipgrid Video Editor is Fantastic

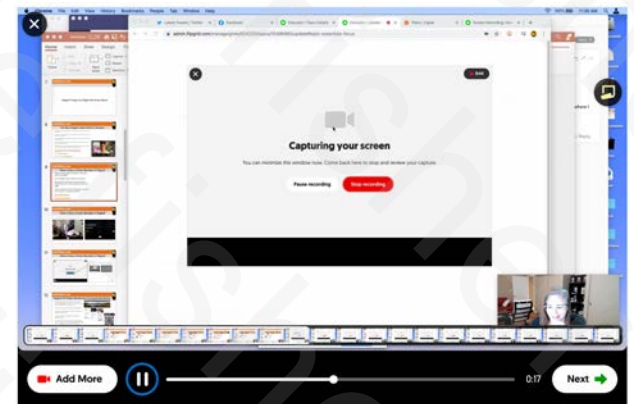
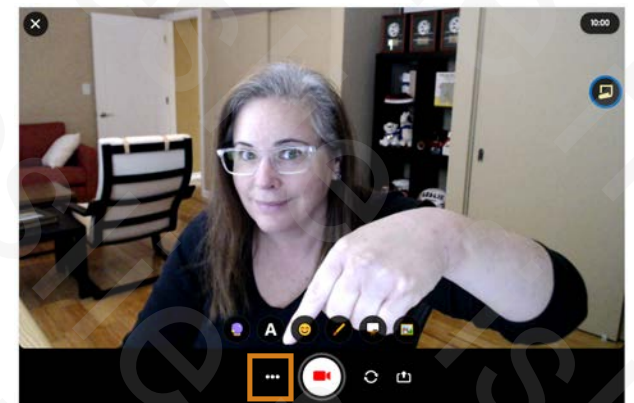
- Works on Chrome (this thing is great on a Chromebook) as well as any web browser, iOS and Android.
- On mobile, you can flip the camera as your record. Perfect for switching from a scene or document to your noggin.
- In August Flipgrid updated the video editor and made it one of the best video editors on Chrome and its free!
- Record and edit multiple scenes of video. Add text, filter, emojis and a whiteboard all which can be toggled on and off.
- Teachers can access this from the Shorts feature. Students can access this from any grid they have access to. I suggest making them a video creation grid.

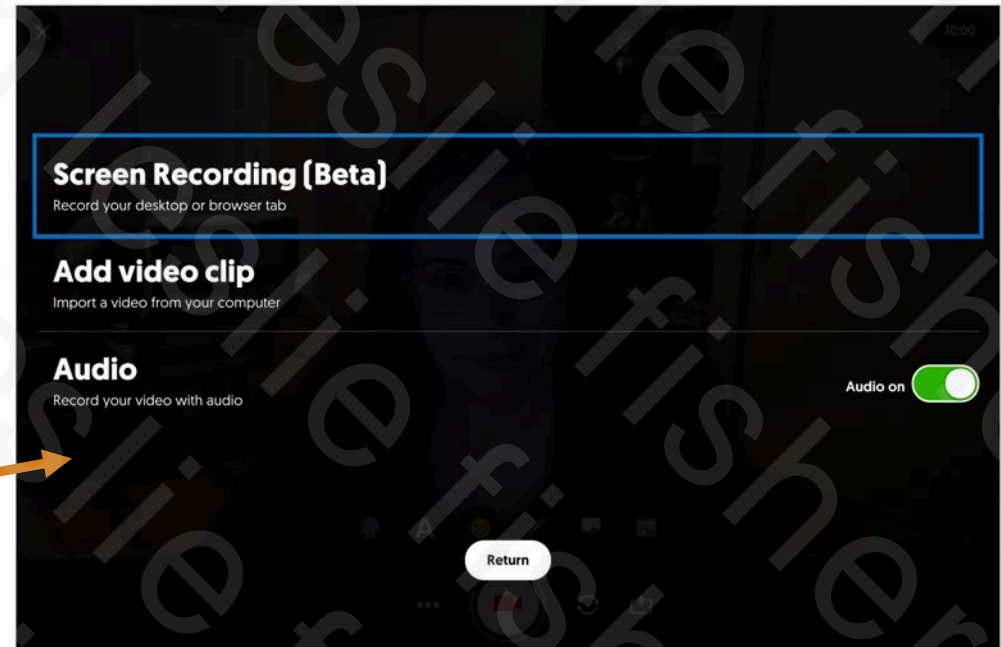
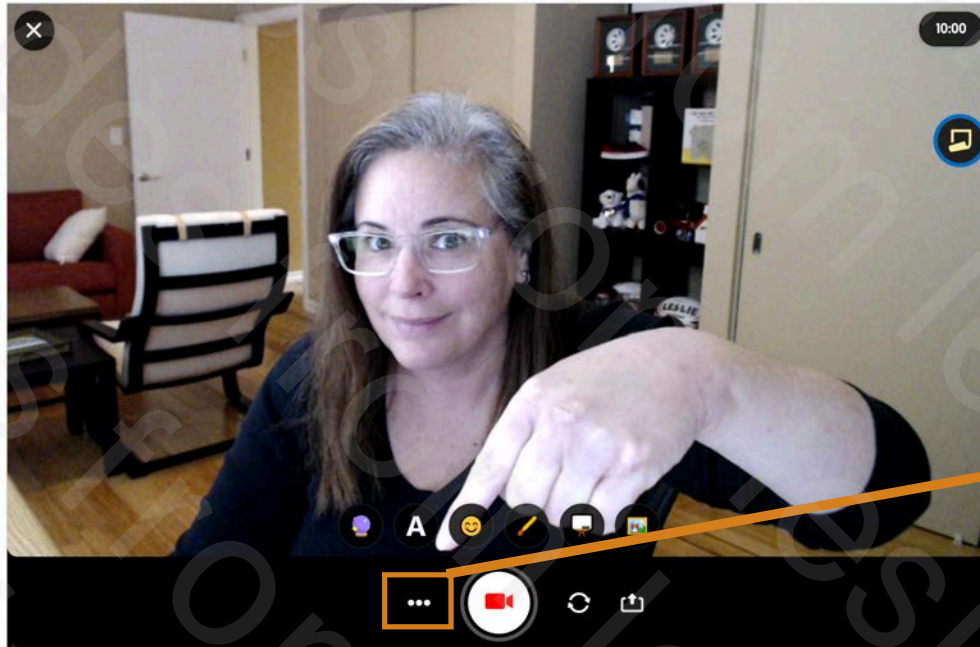
There is Now a Screen Recorder in Flipgrid!

- Flipgrid recently added the ability to record your screen into Flipgrid.
- This is available to both teachers and students
- Not only will it record your screen it will add an additional picture in picture window to show your noggin
- You can choose to share an entire screen, a portion of the screen or an individual web tab
- You can also pause and resume recording
- Keep in mind, Flipgrid recorder lets you have multiple clips so you can easily switch back to just recording yourself or something else in the next clip

The outbreak of COVID-19 (coronavirus) has caused many educational institutions to close temporarily and rely on distance learning.

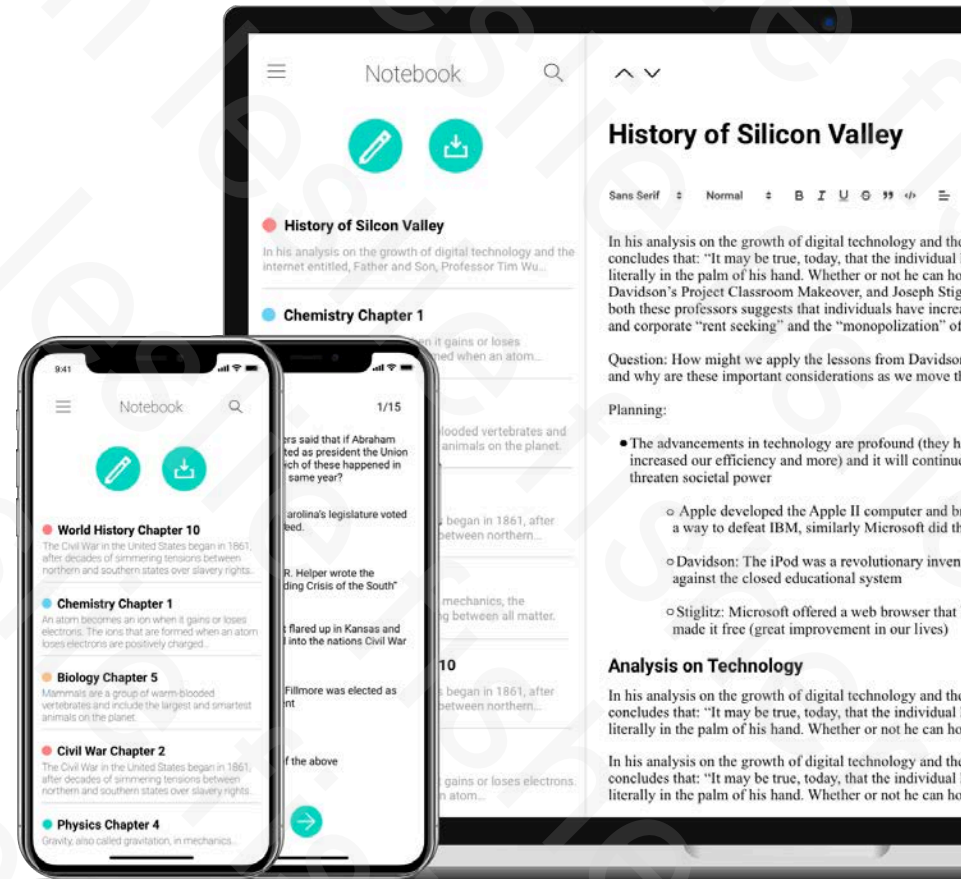

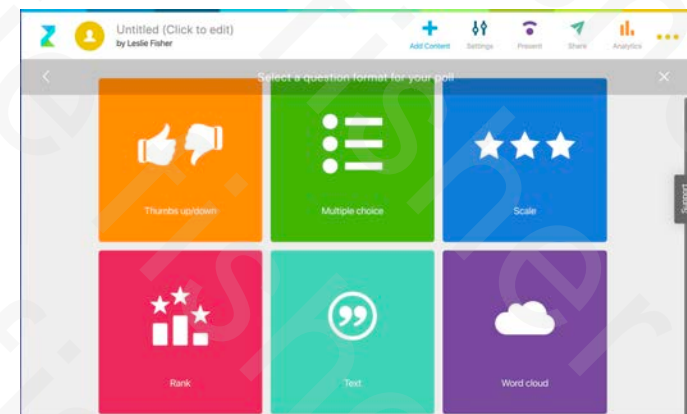
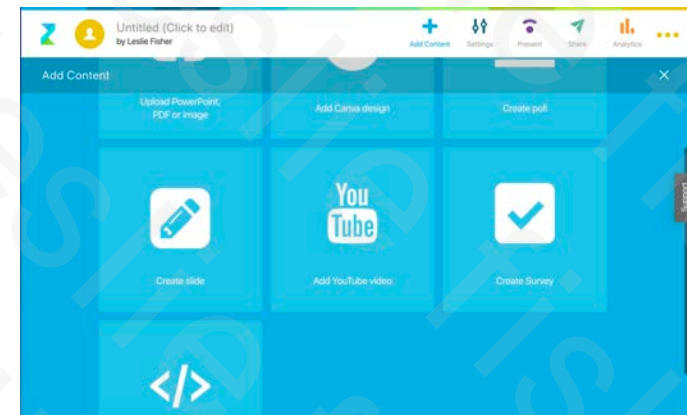

- Uses machine learning to automatically turn your notes into review quizzes
- You can use Knowt to keep all of your notes or import your notes from Google Drive
- At any point you can click on the quiz button which will quiz you on your notes.
- Based on the amount of notes you have your choices for quiz answer will be multiple choice or fill in the blank
- Free, but plans to release premium features in the near future





Zeetings

- Easily create slide like content and engage your audience to interact with them.
- Interaction is simply a link so can be used for remote interaction as well.
- Six question format: thumbs up/thumbs down, ranking polls, text polls, star ratings, multiple choice.
- Add images, videos, embed content even PDFs!
- BYOD
- All Zeetings can be reviewed post zeeting to see percentages, ratings, etc
- If you are an educator you qualify for a free 500 participators per session license.





Microsoft PowerPoint. PowerPoint Live

- PowerPoint Live brings the power of the conversation feature of Microsoft Translator to PowerPoint
- Available on PowerPoint Web Only
- Select Present Live from the Slide Show menu in PowerPoint
- PowerPoint will then generate a link and QR code which can be used by any device capable of heading to a web browser
- User can select from over 60 languages
- Presenter then enters Live mode. The slides will appear on their device and below the slide will be dictation of what the presenter is saying translated into whatever language the user selected
- When the presenter moves to the next slide, the user's device will update automatically
- User can send various emojis along the way as feedback and save the presentation transcript

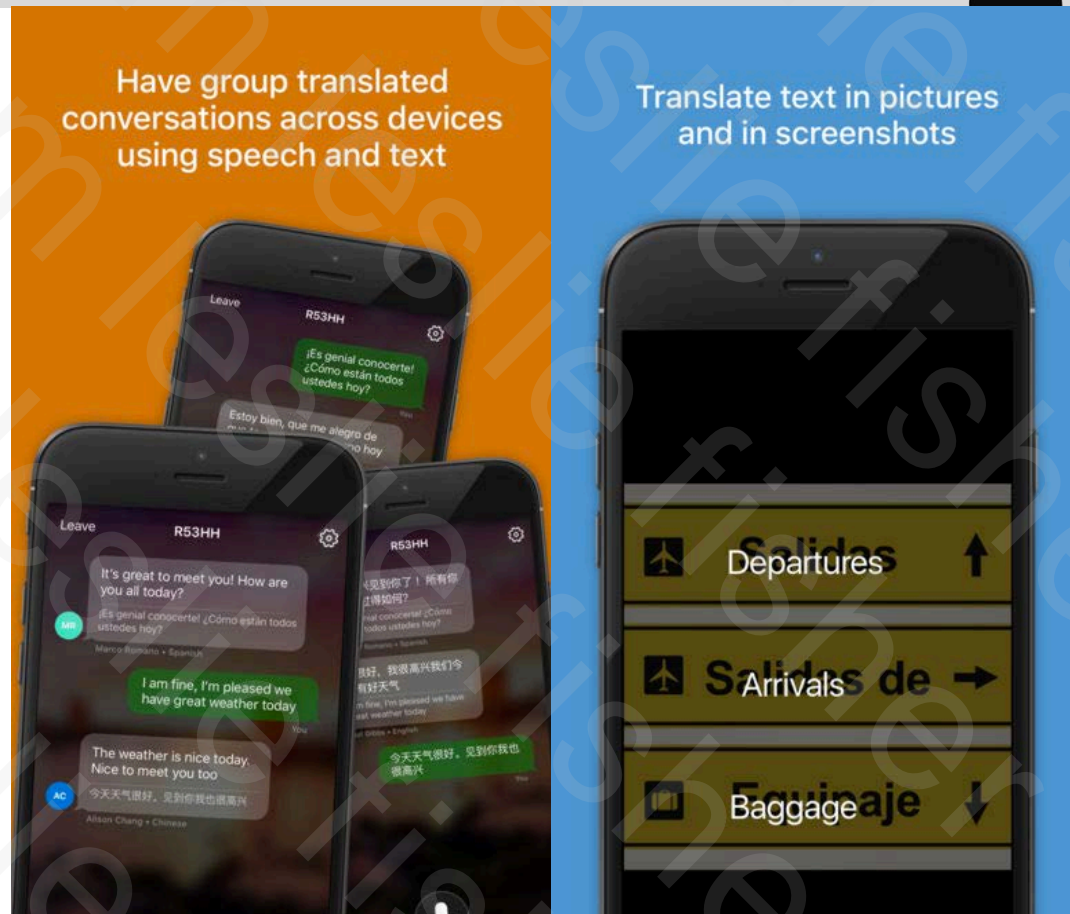

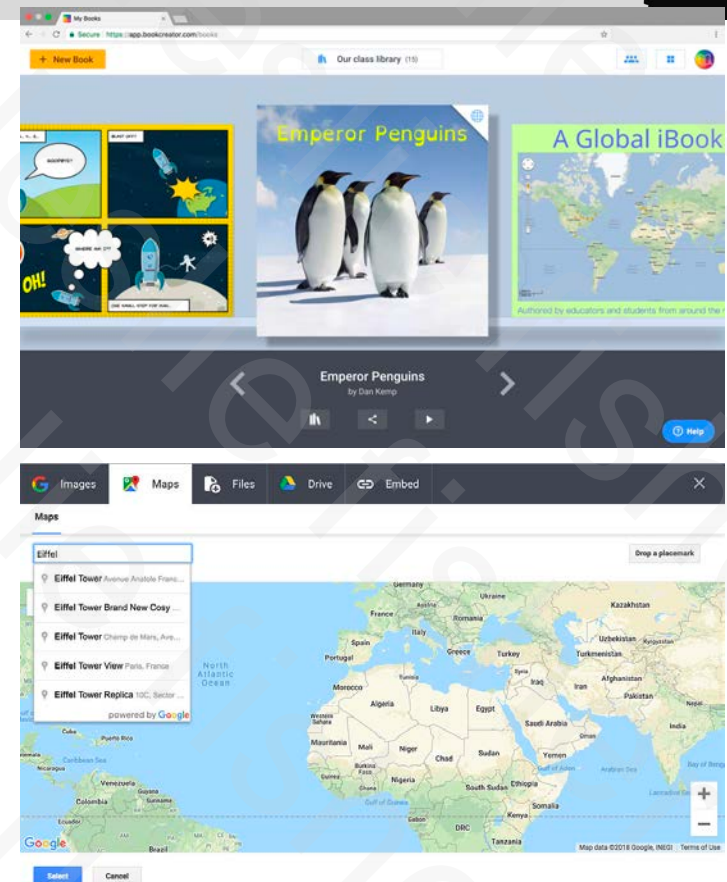

Book Creator

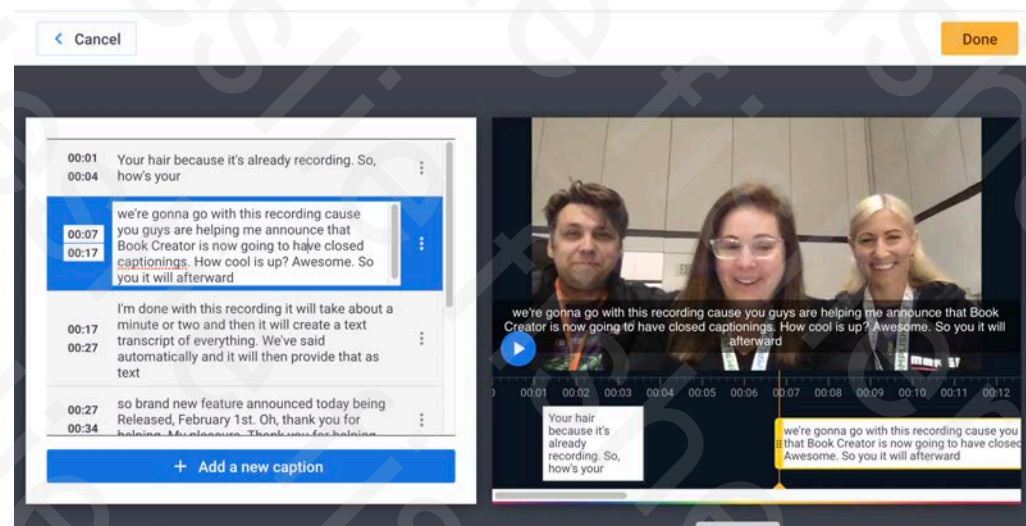

- A great BYOD solution to allow students to easily create books
- Add text, graphics, shapes, audio, video images easily. Drawing tool now has support for Google Autodraw!
- Updated fall 2018 to include embedding from supporting websites. (ty of web sources including Fliprgrid, YouTube, 360 Maps, Google Maps, Google Drive and a host of others.)
- Books can be exported to the web, .pdf or printed
- Teacher gets 40 books for free which can be removed and not count towards total number. \$60 + for additional books





New Updates To Book Creator

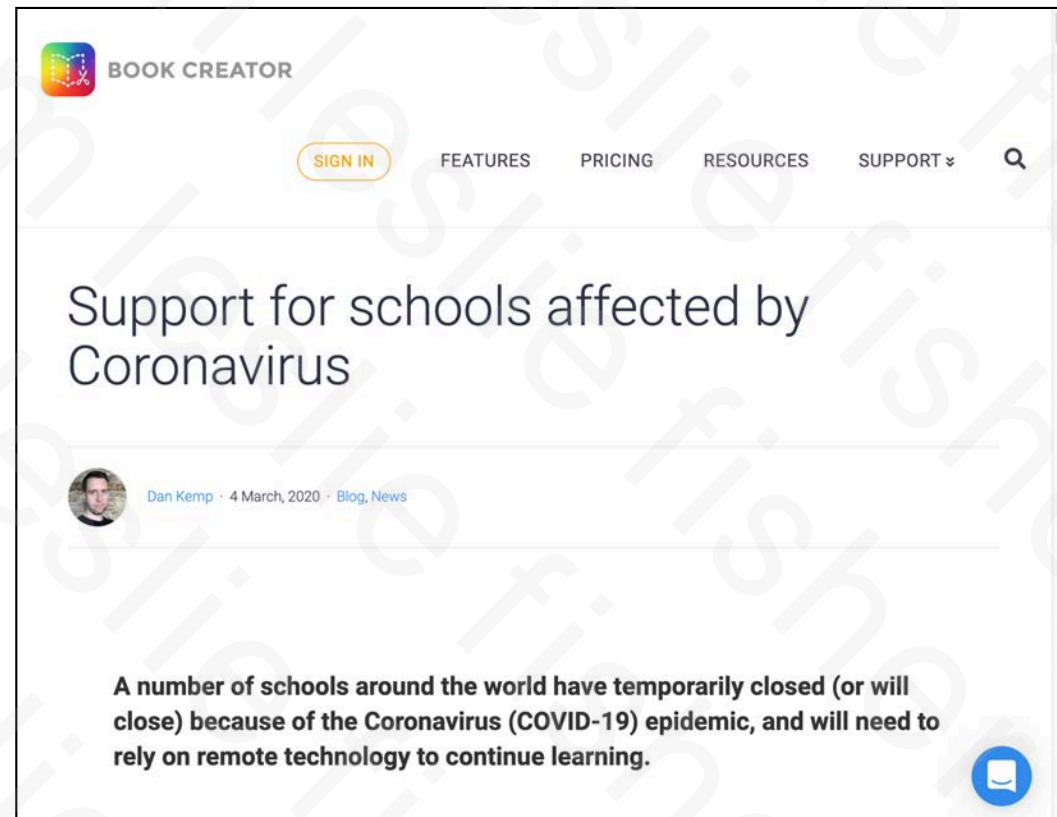

- You can now dictate text in 120 different languages
- Automatic Subtitles in videos.
