






Creating a Buncee: Adding Shapes, Editing Border & Fill Color

- Add all the polygons, mathematical shapes, and simple pictures you want! You'll be able to customize any shape's border width, border color, and fill color. Click the yellow 'Shapes' button located on the Media Palette
- Once you've added a shape from the shapes menu, you'll be able to change the thickness of that shape's border by selecting the object and locating the word 'Border' on the action panel at the bottom of the canvas. Click on the plus or minus buttons to control the thickness of that border.
- You can also use the action panel to also choose the fill color and opacity





Buncee: Adding Slides

- To the left of your Buncee canvas is Pages which allows you to add as many additional pages as your want to tell your story via Buncee
- To add a new slide, locate the Slide Panel to the left of the Creation Canvas then click on the plus sign located beneath your first slide

How To Clip & Stitch Slides Of A Buncee


- With Buncee's Clip & Stitch feature, users can take slides from an existing Buncee and create a new Buncee or integrate them into a new or previously made Buncee.
- For example, teachers can clip slides from their students' Buncees and combine them to create one Buncee of all their students' work!
- To Clip and Stitch, Find and open the Share Menu located on the right top corner of your Buncee, and under the 'Settings' tab, toggle 'Copyable' to 'On'. While in Edit Mode, click on the 'Settings' icon located in the top middle section of the Buncee canvas, and make sure that 'Stitching' is toggled to 'On' as well.










- Click the 'Clip Pages' button. Now your selected slides have been clipped and saved in your account!



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Change The Size of Buncee Canvas

Copying a Buncee


- With Buncee's Copy feature, users can make template copies of Buncee's without affecting the original Buncee. Handy for students to then edit copies created by you or others.
- To use Buncee's Clip & Stitch Feature, the copy feature must be turned on first
- To allow people to Copy your Buncee, Look and click on the Share Button in the upper right corner then switch the 'Copyable' toggle to 'On' with the Settings option. Once Copyable is toggled on recipients will see a 'Copy' button on the top while viewing the Buncee you shared
- When you toggle Copyable on this also give you the ability to duplicate your buncee.

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Adding Audio to Buncee Items



- Select any asset on your canvas, such as stickers, animations, text, web images, or assessment items.
- On the action panel located below the canvas, you'll see a button titled 'Audio'. Then, click on the red record button to start recording.
- When you've finished recording, click on the Stop button, then on 'Upload'
- You'll now have the option to play your audio through clicking on the little triangle on the left, then either 'Remove' or 'Add' it to your canvas. You can also click on the three dots on the right to download your audio file.
- In Preview Mode, you or others can now click on the play buttons to play your audio!

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

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
How To Create Classes & Student Accounts


- If you are a teacher using a Classroom or Buncee for Schools & Districts account, you will be able to easily create Classes and make student accounts within the Classroom Dashboard.
- After logging in, click on the 'Classes' tab at the top left corner to open your Classroom Dashboard. In this Classroom Dashboard, you will see a list of Classes that are currently in your account, as well as the 'Add New Class' option for creating a new Class. Click on New Class, and type in the 'Class Name' and 'Subject'. You can also select a Grade level from the drop-down menu when you click on 'Grade'. Then, click 'Create'.





Adding Students To a Class

- While students can create accounts and add themselves to your Class by
 entering your Class Code, younger learners might prefer having their
 accounts set up for them by the teacher. As the teacher, you can add
 students to your class via Manual Upload, adding from an existing student
 list, or by uploading a CSV file
- In your Classroom Dashboard, select the Class you'd like to add students to. Click on the pink 'Add Students' button on the right side of your Dashboard. Fill in the student's login credentials, then click on the '+' sign to add that student to your list. Continue the process for all students in your Class.
- Click on the 'Import from CSV' tab, and follow the instructions for uploading CSV files. Make sure that you have named your headers 'first_name', 'last_name', 'username', and 'password'.








Google Classroom and Microsoft Teams Roster Support


- Yes! You can sync your Google Classroom or Microsoft Teams rosters with Buncee. Requires a Buncee Schools and Districts account
- Once your school/district acquires a Buncee for Schools & Districts account, head to your custom domain to sign into your profile.
- You will then sign in to your Classroom or Teams Account
- Google Classroom: Once you're signed into Buncee for Schools & Districts, head
 to the Classes tab of your dashboard. The Classes tab is found in the top left of
 your screen. Select the red "Sync With Google Classroom" button to pull your
 roster information from Google Classroom, creating your classes and your
 students' Buncee accounts.
- Microsoft Teams: Once your school/district has purchased Buncee for Schools & Districts, head to your custom domain and Select sign in with Microsoft. On the Buncee Dashboard, select "Sync with Office 365".



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




- With your assignment, attach Buncees for your students to view and answer questions from. There's no limit to how many you can add to one assignment. If students are required to create & submit a Buncee in response, switch the toggle that says "Are students required to submit a Buncee?" to 'Yes.'
- Choose when students will see the correct answer to quizzes by changing the 'Feedback Level'. Choose which students you would like to receive the assignment: you can choose from whole classes, a particular group, a custom selection, or even individual students then choose start and due dates for your assignment. Your assignment will be created and sent and will viewable in the assignment list of the class on your Classroom Dashboard.







Track Students Progress on a Buncee


- You can track a students progress on a Buncee


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
Viewing and Grading Student Assignments

- Click on the Comments icon in the top right corner of the Buncee Board and After typing your comment, click on 'Add Comment'.
- To view and reply to comments: Click on the Comments icon in the top right corner to view all the comments and replies on the Buncee Board and Click on 'Reply' under the comment you wish to reply to. Type your reply, then click on the send button.
- To View New Comments & Replies Using Refresh, When multiple users are interacting on the same Buncee Board at the same time, it could be useful to refresh the list of comments to view the latest ones. Simply click on the refresh button on the top right of the comments panel to see the latest comments and replies!



Use Buncee Within Microsoft Teams Messaging

- You can add Buncee as a Messaging App within Microsoft Teams
- The support article below has a different process but, here is mine: Click on New Conversation in a Channel in Microsoft Teams and look for the three dots in your New Message options. Click on the dots to display installed messaging apps and search for Buncee. Once you see it listed in the search results select Buncee to install it
- You will now have a Buncee icon as an option in Messages and clicking on it will display various Buncee stickers




- While in Microsoft Teams, click the Apps option in the lower left corner and then Search for Buncee and add the Buncee App










- With this update, teachers can set up a live lesson with the whole class, or a one-on-one session with a particular student
- Click on the Microsoft Teams log on the top of your Buncee web page. You will then have the option to create a meeting and share the meeting invite with students

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New: Add a Buncee Tab into a Microsoft Teams Meeting

- · You can now have a Buncee option within a Microsoft Teams Meeting
- This will let you view a Buncee that everyone can see and interact with (not collaborate) you can even add a question to each page of the Buncee
- When you launch your Microsoft Teams meetings you will see an icon for Buncee which when the meeting host clicks the icon will deploy the Buncee for others to see
- As of now this option is not supported when you schedule a Teams Meeting in a channel. This should change soon
- To use this option, schedule a Teams Meeting no in a channel with at least one
 required participant. Schedule the meeting then click to edit the meeting once
 added to the meeting calendar. You will now see a plus at the top of the meeting
 information. Click there to add the Buncee app and then choose which Buncee
 you want to add to the meeting. It will then display the option to add questions
 to each buncee slide














