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The Student Learning Plan (SLP) is a legal document outlining programming for identified gifted and talented students and is used as a guide for educational planning and decision making. It is also an accountability method for assessing gifted student growth through progress monitoring of quantitative and qualitative goals in gifted student programming and social emotional development. The requirements of both the SLP need to be combined on the singular portfolio system where data is collected and goals established and monitored. Stakeholders [teacher(s), student and their parent(s)/guardian(s)] need to partner together for student success with explicit role expectations for sharing responsibility, workable logistics, genuine invitations to collaborate and mutually respectful relationships. By collaborating together on a SLP there is a mutual target for coordinating student learning in and out of school.

Please contact your child's school's Gifted and Talented teacher to schedule the date and time that would work for you to meet online. Once these details are given to the GT teacher, you will get an email with a link to the KIBSD videoconferencing system that will be used to conduct the SLP.
