## Paper Pinwheel Directions

One team member cuts on the lines BUT
 DOES NOT CUT INSIDE OF THE CIRCLE.
Fold all the corners down to the middle of the paper and use one piece of tape to hold all four corners down in the middle.


Other team members work on taping three cups together like in the picture on the right.

After all three cups are taped together, tape on a popsicle stick so that it is as high as it can be sticking up but still has a strong anchor to the cups.

Take a pushpin and a pink eraser and poke a hole in the middle of the paper pinwheel. Place the sharp point of the pinwheel through the hole at the end of the popsicle stick and anchor it into the eraser so that the pinwheel is secured onto the stick.
